(compound of two tetrahedra)

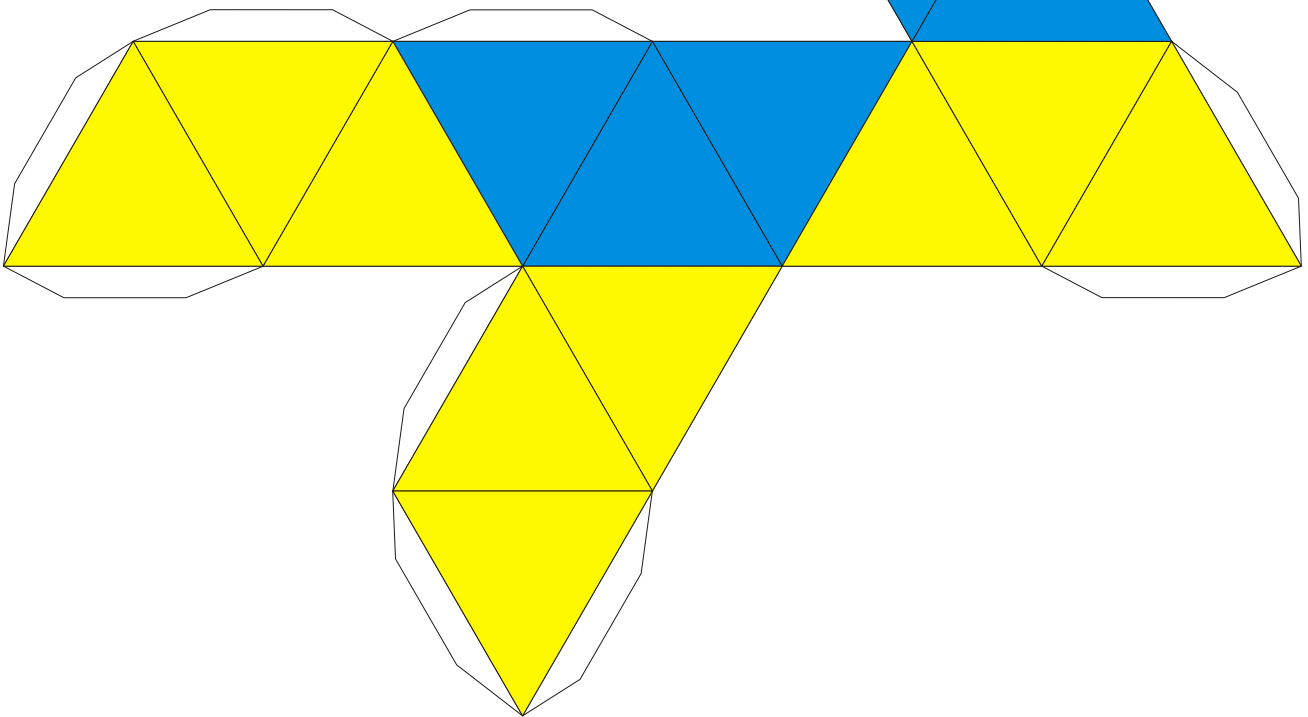
(small version out of one part)

Fold the other lines forwards

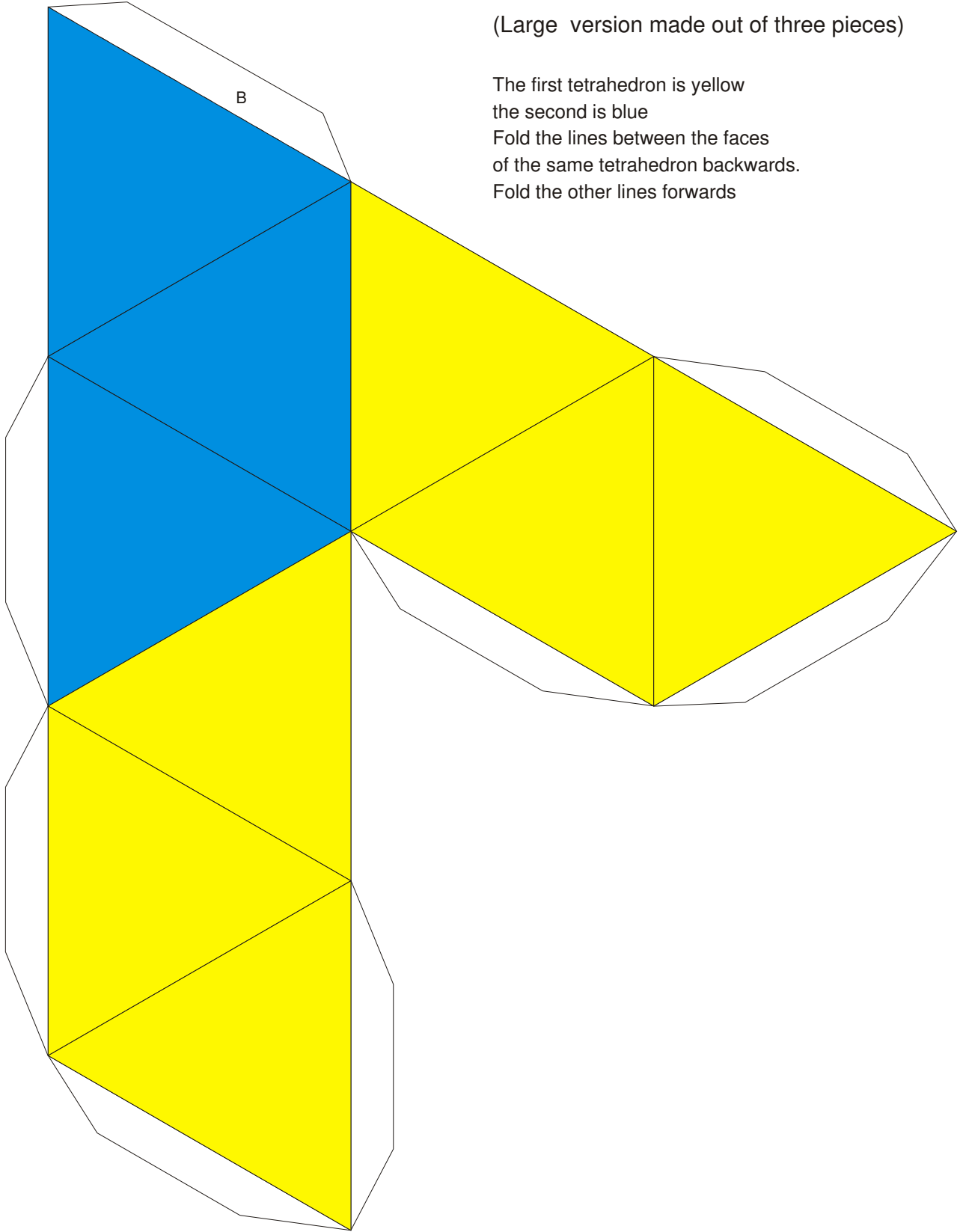

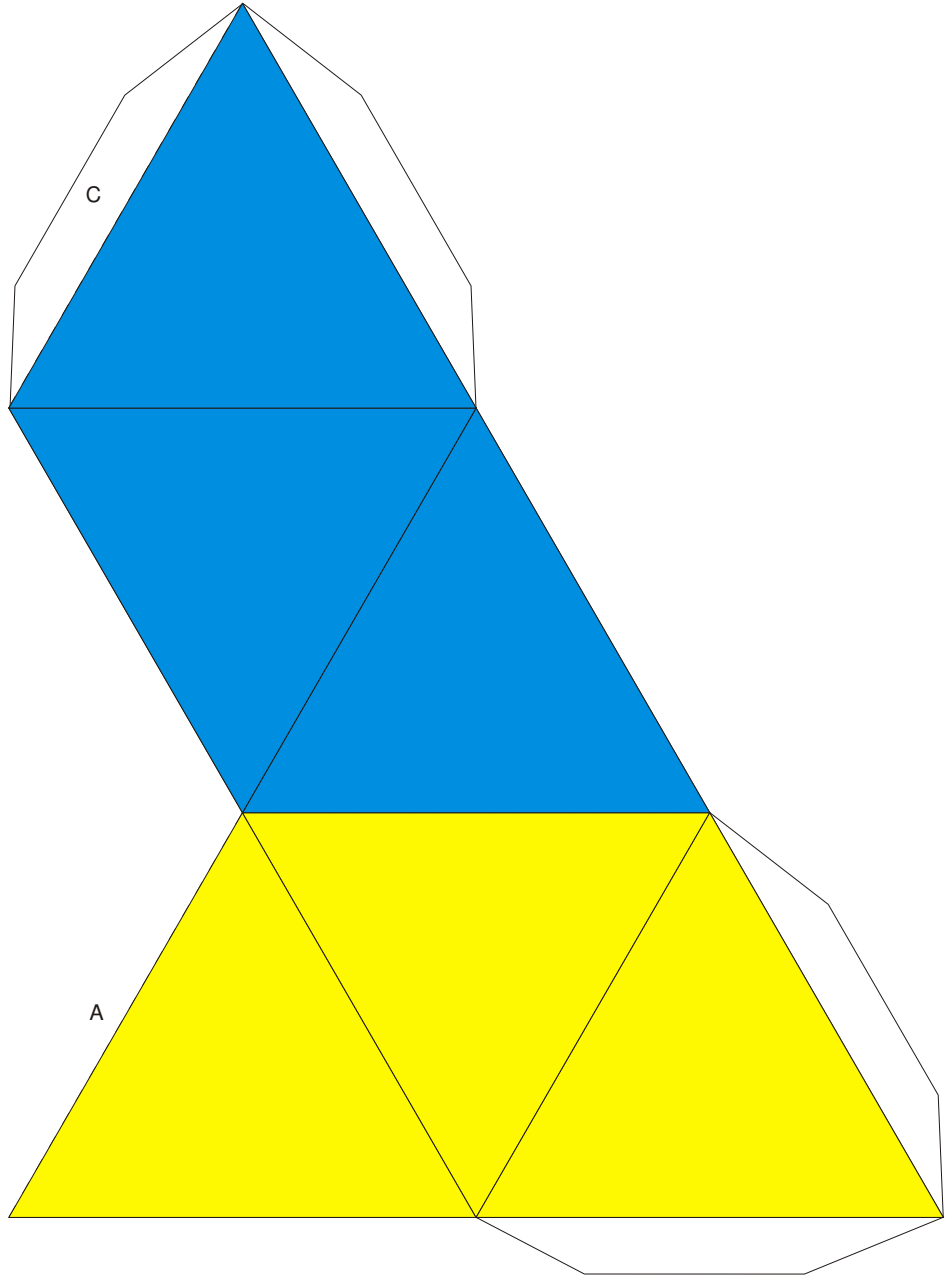

(Large version made out of three pieces)

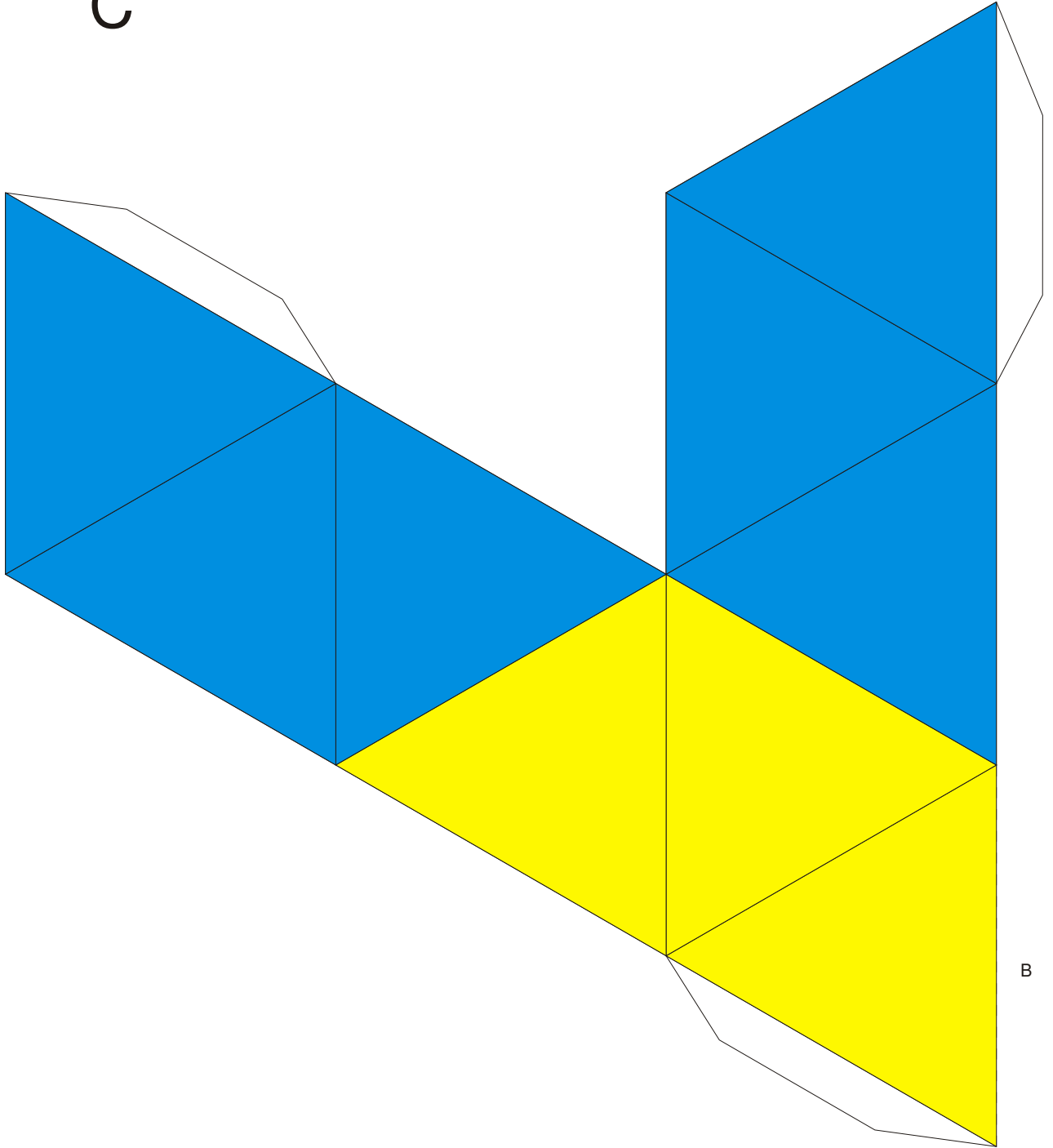
The first tetrahedron is yellow
